Proposed Hangar 2 Project Now On LowryLink

A group page has been established on LowryLink dedicated to the Hangar 2 proposed redevelopment project. Once logged into LowryLink, go to the right-hand side of the page where there is a drop down menu of Lowry businesses and groups. The Hangar 2 page is at the top of the list. The page includes Wings Over the Rockies information, proposed redevelopment plans and an outline of the public process for the proposed project.

Last month, International Risk Group and Wings Over the Rockies Museum withdrew their application to the Denver Landmark Preservation Commission to further gather community input on the proposed project. Wings Over the Rockies and IRG will start an extended community outreach program to garner additional community input on the project.

The community grant program was created to redirect funds back into the community for projects and programs that will enhance the quality of life for Lowry residents and businesses. Grants are awarded twice a year in amounts ranging from \$250 to \$2,500. The grant committee values collaborative efforts and strongly favors applications that clearly demonstrate how they serve the Lowry Community.

In reviewing proposals for funding, the Lowry Foundation looks for projects that:

- promote volunteer and community involvement
- encourage cooperation and collaboration

- are of artistic, educational, cultural, historical and recreational nature
- have the ability to leverage other funding sources

The Lowry Foundation does not fund endowments, capital campaigns, special events, fundraising, religious purposes, political lobbying and projects that do not specifically serve the Lowry community.
